**Mayor Ben Lawrence called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.**

**21<sup>st</sup> Street entry monument**

David Foster explained the process and progress of this monument since 2008. He then presented up to date information on the design and installation of the monument to be located on the north side of 21<sup>st</sup> Street east of 159<sup>th</sup> Street. The Council concurred the lettering and graphics to be sandblasted into limestone, with Lithichrome paint coloring for the 17'6" H x 19'4" W monument at an approximate cost of \$25,500.

**Park amphitheater location**

David Foster explained Rice-Foster had been asked by the CVB to move forward with Phase II of the design for the proposed amphitheater in Central Park and Rice-Foster asked the Council for a more definitive location in the park before moving forward with the feasibility study. The Council concurred the north site would be the appropriate location.

**Park Master Plan update**

David Foster explained this master plan is a component of the Comprehensive Development Plan and should have a steering committee appointed to begin the plan process. Council Members Troy Tabor, Sheri Geisler, and Caroline Hale volunteered to lead the committee that will be appointed by the Mayor.
