Fire Department budget

Fire Chief Russell, Deputy Fire Chief Roosevelt and Fire Reserve Chief Andy Saville presented the 2017 proposed budget. Justifications were provided for an additional firefighter that would also be responsible for staff training. The CIP included requests for resurfacing of station floors, replacing the Jaws of Life, replacement of Brush Truck 11 including new apparatus, parking lot repairs, a plan to update for station remodel, and hiring a consultant to begin the implementation of a Standard of Cover.

Andover YMCA Board liaison

Mark Detter stated the YMCA was looking for a council liaison to assist with fund raising, events, etc. and sit as a board member for the YMCA. Council Member Kris Estes volunteered to be the liaison but would not participate as a board member.

FLSA-moving employees from salary to hourly

Mark Detter wanted to assure the Council that staff had addressed new labor standards for the pay of exempt employees.

Les Mangus explained the current street policy.
