The Council discussed the franchising of trash in the City. Jack Chappell a consultant with Engineering Solutions and Design in Overland Park was present for the discussion. Mr. Chappell is under contract with Butler County to work on their solid waste management plan and their recycling plan. The Mayor stated that this is something to look at in the future. The Governing Body then discussed the latest recommendations from the Park Planning Committee. A possible sales tax election later in the year to pay for the improvements was discussed. Park improvements
