The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Council President Clark Nelson. Call to Order

Paul Sook addressed the Council regarding the possible formation of a steering committee and the potential for a scope of work being developed in reference to the development of a Master Development Plan for the Andover Recreation Department. An ad hoc committee has been formed with representatives from the school district, the community and the Andover Recreation Department. The group is interested in soliciting RFP's from consulting firms for the development of a Master Plan for the Andover Recreation Department. Discussion also included comments regarding the opening of the new Andover YMCA early 2009. Council President Nelson requested cost estimates of what a consulting firm would charge to help develop a master plan. Nelson also indicated that the topic should be brought back to the workshop meeting in June for further discussion. Andover Recreation Department Master Plan Development

Staff briefed the Council regarding possible options for the improvement of Harry Street east of Andover Road. Options discussed included annexation of the area and the possibility of coming to an agreement with the Bruno Township for improved maintenance of the street. Staff was directed to continue working with representatives of Bruno Township to see if an agreement can be reached. Harry Street discussion

Discussion of KDOT's approval of Andover's request for planning funds for the Highway 54 corridor included direction from the Council that the included agreement between KDOT and the City of Andover be brought to the next regular meeting of the City Council for discussion and possible action.
