Minutes

Mayor Lawrence, Council Members Jessen, Nelson, Reams and Hale were in attendance for the dedication of the Founders Memorial by Eagle Scout Ryan Parsons.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by Mayor Lawrence.

Others in attendance:

City Administrator Sasha Stiles, Director of Public Works and Community Development Les Mangus, Assistant City Administrator Shane Coelho, Police Chief Mike Keller and City Clerk Susan Renner.

Police Chief Keller presented a video clip for CrimeReports.com. The police department is currently evaluating the programs on a trial basis at no charge. They are affordable analytical programs that allows law enforcement to manage crime data through a web-based interface and allows citizens to view crime and accident information.

Crime Report Mapping

Chief Keller stated that if the service is something the Council would like to pursue the purchase the cost for the first year is \$2,917.20 for both CrimeReports and CommandCentral programs.

Chief Keller added that the cost could be covered through the departments current budget.

Sasha Stiles stated staff has been working to close the gap on the \$230,000 shortfall for the improvements to pave 159<sup>th</sup> to the school north of 21<sup>st</sup> Street. Staff would like to approach LaFarge, while still on site with the 21<sup>st</sup> Street improvements being done for the City of Wichita, adding the possibility of savings with them already on site.

Mrs. Stiles added that Ritchie & Laham Development Companies have each committed an additional \$80,000 for the project and the City an additional \$300,000 in the 2010 budget.

Sasha Stiles stated Gossen Livingston Architects are doing a great job and will have plans ready for bid in a couple of weeks and added that City Counsel

Norman Manley and the City's insurance company has been reviewing the AIA documents.

The Council discussed assessed and estimated actual value of taxable property, mill levies, residential and commercial construction, the rise in interest rates, and potential financing options. The Council concurred to move to the next phase of planning the project.
