Minutes

1. Call to Order

Mayor Lawrence called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

2. Roll Call

City Council Members present were Council Member Byron Stout IV, Council Member Sheri Geisler, Council Member Dave Tingley, Council Member Clark Nelson, Council Member Troy Tabor, Council Member Caroline Hale (arrived at 7:07 p.m.) and Mayor Ben Lawrence

5. Public Forum

Pastor Robert Lukenbill, Andover Church of Christ, stated the church was opening a clothing closet for anyone in need. Currently the emphasis for donations is on clothing for school age children. Pastor Lukenbill added the group will not be accepting any cash donations.
