Mayor Ben Lawrence called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

WAMPO Operation Funding

Bill Christian gave a presentation on WAMPO, the membership, its purpose and how the distribution of federal funding is handled. He explained the need to move from in-kind services for the required local match for federal funds to a local revenue stream. Local annual assessments are currently being presented to WAMPO members for consideration. The estimated annual membership fee for the City of Andover is \$1,200-\$2,400, depending on the number of members in the organization. A community must be a member of WAMPO to participate in the federal funding of projects and must enter into a re-designation agreement and fiscal agreement in order to be a member of WAMPO .

Public Project CIP

Les Mangus presented a summary of public improvement projects including; 159th Street 3-lane improvement from KTA bridge north to 21st Street; Redbud Trail project from 159th to the 13th Street Sports Park; traffic light installation at Andover Road and Harry Street; and the widening of Andover Road to four lanes from Four Mile Creek to 120th Street south with turn lanes and signals.

Mayor Ben Lawrence asked to have Yorktown from Central to US 54 added to the list of projects.

A motion was made by Council Member Sheri Geisler, seconded by Council Member Kris Estes, at 8:15 p.m. to adjourn. Motion carried 6/0
